HOLY WEEK SCHEDULE

Please see the flyer in today's bulletin for the Holy Week schedule. Due to Covid-19, neither the washing of the feet on Holy Thursday or the kissing of the Cross during Veneration on Good Friday will take place (please bow or genuflect before the Cross). If any Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Ushers or Altar Servers would like to volunteer to serve, Msgr. ask that they be ready at the allotted place and time during any of the Mass. Please rotate serving as needed, wear a mask, and thank you for serving during Holy Week.

LENTEN FRIDAY SCHEDULE

On Fridays during Lent, Stations of the Cross will be at 5:30pm and Msgr. Hofmann will hear confessions from 6:00pm to 7:00pm in the church office. Via Crucis will be at 7:00pm.

FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Good Friday is an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, all Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal. Two smaller meals may also be taken, but not to equal a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

Please remember in your prayers those catechumens and candidates receiving sacraments at the Great Easter Vigil and on Easter Sunday at the Spanish Mass.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

If you or a family member anticipate going into the hospital, please notify the church office as soon as possible so that the anointing of the sick may be arranged. If at all possible, please do not wait until the situation becomes dire before calling for the Sacrament.
