Parish Membership

Active members of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure. Stewardship is determined by:

- 1.) Being properly registered (required of everyone who is at least 18 years of age) and has been active in the parish for a minimum of three months;
- 2.) Faithful participation at weekly liturgies;
- 3.) Involvement in at least one ministry, program, activity or organization in the parish;
- 4.) Regular and identifiable financial support of the parish.

These criteria are used to appraise or verify parishioner status for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries, activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and services.

ARE YOU A REGISTERED PARISHIONER?

To avoid any misunderstandings when planning baptisms, marriages, or when you have a special request of the parish, **be sure that you are a registered and active member of the parish.** Registration forms are available in the church vestibule. It may be dropped in the offertory basket or you may bring it by the church office for processing.

DO YOU KNOW ANY RETIRED MILITARY?

If so, please inform them that, in accordance to the laws of the Catholic Church, only Active Duty personnel have the right to fulfill their Sunday Obligation and receive Sacraments from a Military Chapel, such as All Saints Chapel, located on the Naval Weapons Station. All retired military Catholic families are required to register and attend their local parish. Thank you for spreading the word and helping to avoid any future misunderstandings.
