- 1.) Being properly registered (required of everyone who is at least 18 years of age) and has been active in the parish for a minimum of three months;
- 2.) Faithful participation at weekly liturgies;
- 3.) Involvement in at least one ministry, program, activity or organization in the parish;
- 4.) Regular and identifiable financial support of the parish.

These criteria are used to appraise or verify parishioner status for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries, activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and services.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

If you or a family member anticipate entering the hospital for major surgery or a prolonged illness, please notify the church office as soon as possible so that the anointing of the sick may be arranged before entering the hospital. The anointing may take place after Mass or in the church office. If at all possible, please do not wait until the situation becomes dire before calling for the Sacrament. Once the soul has left the body, it is too late. Please know that not all area hospitals provide "Clergy Parking" and Msgr. Hofmann does not want to be too late to anoint you or your loved one. Also, please know that according to Church Law, the Sacrament is not to be administered multiple times. Once you or your loved one has been anointed for a specific condition, that is all that is required for one's soul.
