- 2.) Faithful participation at weekly liturgies;
- 3.) Involvement in at least one ministry, program, activity
or organization in the parish;
- 4.) Regular and identifiable financial support of the
parish.

These criteria are used to appraise or verify parishioner status
for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in
sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries,
activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and
services.
