Parish Membership

Active members of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure. Stewardship is determined by:

- 1.) Being properly registered (required of everyone who is at least 18 years of age) and has been active in the parish for a minimum of three months;
 - 2.) Faithful participation at weekly liturgies;
 - 3.) Involvement in at least one ministry, program, activity or organization in the parish;
 - 4.) Regular and identifiable financial support of the parish.
- These criteria are used to appraise or verify parishioner status for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries, activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and services.

All Parents/Guardians of candidates for First Holy Communion are invited to attend a very important meeting regarding the requirements for the

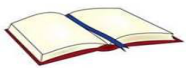
