### Parish Membership

Active members of our parish are identified by their generosity of time, talent and treasure. Stewardship is determined by:

- 1.) Being properly registered (required of everyone who is at least 18 years of age) and has been active in the parish for a minimum of three months;
- 2.) Faithful participation at weekly liturgies;
- 3.) Involvement in at least one ministry, program, activity or organization in the parish;
- 4.) Regular and identifiable financial support of the parish.

These criteria are used to appraise or verify parishioner status for sponsorship, parochial schools, participation in sacramental, educational, pastoral and social ministries, activities and enrichment programs, and use of facilities and services.

### FOR A SYNODAL CHURCH

Pope Francis has convened a synod that will run from October 2021 to October 2023. Its theme is "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission." The opening Mass for our local synod will be Sunday, October 17<sup>th</sup>, at 11:15 a.m. at the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist in Charleston. Divine Redeemer Church will also have an opening Mass at our parish to celebrate the beginning of this historic event. In the coming weeks, our parishioners will be invited to participate in listening sessions to discern future direction of the Church, with a questionnaire sent to be completed. All data will be analyzed, summarized, answers collected and an Executive Report will be written by the local Synodal team to be sent on to the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops.
