**Bishop Kagan has reinstated the Sunday Mass Obligation beginning the first Sunday of Lent (Feb 20/21)**

The best we human beings can give to God in this world is what He Himself gave us, His Body and Blood in the Eucharistic Sacrifice initiated at the Last Supper. So to come to Sunday Mass every week is the very best way we can cultivate and strengthen our virtue of religion and in turn be holy as the Lord Himself is holy. Again, since "The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of Christian practice" (CCC 2181), the Church teaches us that it is an obligation we have and owe to God and, as such, we should desire and want to do this more than anything else.

**Lenten Regulations**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

For members of the Latin Catholic Church, the norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Latin Catholic Church from age 14 onwards.

**Changes by the Diocese**

**Reestablishing the Sunday/Holy Day obligation to attend Mass as of the First Sunday of Lent, the weekend of February 20-21,**

1. Spacing in Church is eliminated
2. Funeral Vigils and Visitations before Mass may be in the Church at the Pastor's discretion.
3. Extra-Ordinary Ministers of the Eucharist at the Pastor's discretion may resume for Parish Masses only.
4. Mass Servers at the discretion of the Pastor and with the permission of parents may resume.
5. Choirs for Parish Masses may resume participation with the usual numbers.
6. Holy Water may be put into the fonts in the Church.
7. Penance Services are allowed but only with the use of screens.

**No Change**

1. Holy Communion under the one species of the Consecrated Host.
2. The Sign of Peace remains suspended.
3. No Offertory procession with the gifts.
4. No face-to-face Confessions.

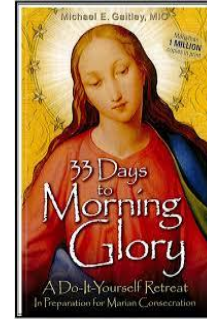
