Replica of Pietà Statue at Cathedral

Five hundred years ago, Michelangelo unveiled what would come to be regarded as one of the world's greatest masterpieces of inspired art – the Pietà. Arte Divine, a worldwide distributor of the reproduction of Michelangelo's Pietà, have placed an exact replica of the original Pietà to the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck. This is a precise "1 to 1" marble casting that is faithful in every detail to Michelangelo's original that currently is located at St. Peter's Basilica in Rome. It will remain at the Cathedral through summer 2021, after which it will be permanently placed at St. Mary's Central High School. The faithful of the diocese are invited to come and pray before this truly moving work of art.
