Our Home and School Association Mums Fundraiser has been a huge success! At last count, we have sold more than 2,000 mums! Plants will be available for pick up on Wednesday beginning at 8:00 AM in the parking lot across the street from the church, adjacent to the Parish Green. Please follow the signs for pick up.

Attention Cross Country athletes in grades 6-8: We are now able to start to begin Cross Country practices and have opened up sign-ups for grades 6-8. We are following the lead of the CIAC in our effort to move forward safely with athletics at our school, and the DPH's most recent letter to the CIAC supported moving forward cross country under normal rules and conditions, after the second week of the school year.

- In accordance with the fall sport season for cross country, activities will be limited to non-contact sport specific skill work and conditioning, in cohorts of 10 until at least September 20th. This structure makes all activities for this sport low risk through September 20th.
- On September 18th, the CIAC will evaluate Connecticut's COVID metrics and inform schools whether activities will progress to full team moderate risk practices on September 21st. If the metrics do not support moving to full team or moderate risk activities on September 21st, all sports will remain in small cohort low risk activities. Updates will be provided to the level of risk that is supported by COVID metrics.
- Meets/Contests may be allowed to begin on or after October 1, if supported by COVID metrics.

An Important Reminder: Please be certain to take your child's temperature every morning. Any temperature of 100°F or higher requires that your child stay home from school. If you are keeping your child home, please contact the office or Diane Raymond, our school nurse.

It is very important that students be taken home promptly after dismissal. Our playscape must remain closed after school. It is cleaned several times during the day after the recess groups.
