**Regarding travel for athletes:** Under CDC and Archdiocesan guidelines, if a student athlete is traveling outside of the state to engage in sports for more than 24 hours, then, upon return to CT, they must be tested and quarantine for 7 days, or not test and quarantine for 10 days. **All athletes must still adhere to the 14 day quarantine period if exposed as a close contact to COVID.**
