Corpus Christi Procession ~ June 6, 2021

On June 6th - the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, traditionally known as, "Corpus Christi"-the Blessed Sacrament will be processed in the Monstrance through downtown Ironwood. Our process begins directly following the 11AM Mass. Parishioners are encouraged to join the procession and pray with us as we display Jesus' body as a sign of our common faith.

The Mystery of the Holy Trinity (Feast of the Most Holy Trinity)

"The Feast of the most Holy Trinity leads us to contemplate the mystery of God who unceasingly creates, redeems and sanctifies, always with love and through love." - Pope Francis, May 27, 2018. The mystery of the Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and life. God reveals himself as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The doctrine of the Trinity includes three truths of faith.

First, the Trinity is One. We do not speak of three gods but of one God. Each of the Persons is fully God. They are a unity of Persons in one divine nature.

Second, the Divine Persons are distinct from each other. Father, Son and Spirit are not three appearances or modes of God, but three identifiable persons, each fully God in a way distinct from the others.

Third, the Divine Persons are in relation to each other. The distinction of each is understood only in reference to the others. The Father cannot be the Father without the Son, nor can the Son be the Son without the Father. The Holy Spirit is related to the Father and the Son who both send him forth.

All Christians are baptized in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. The Trinity illumines all the other mysteries of faith.
