Dear Priests, Deacons and Religious:

I am writing to request your help in an important pro-life effort.

Some powerful Members of Congress want to take away the Hyde Amendment so taxpayer dollars will pay for abortions for poor women.

The Hyde Amendment has been credited with **saving of 2.4 million lives**, and without it, the current abortion rate would likely go up significantly.
