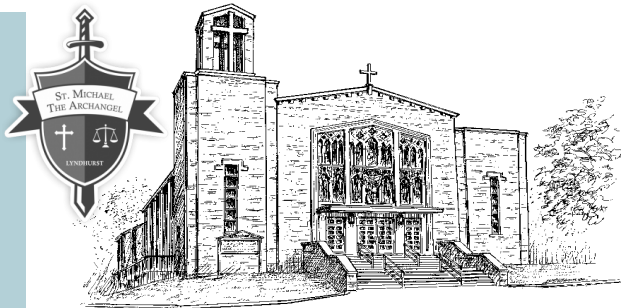

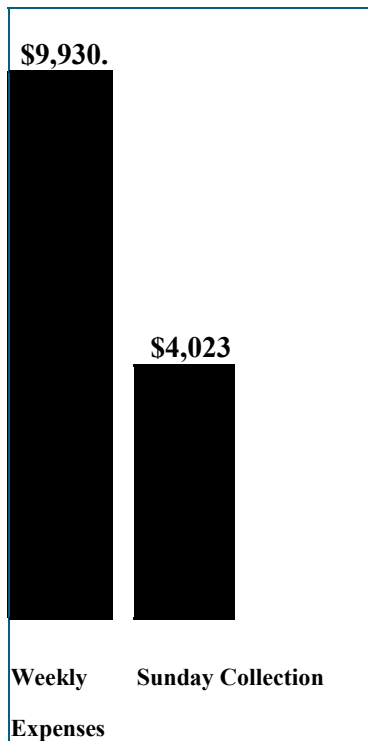
In order for you to become a sponsor for Confirmation or a Godparent for a Baptism, you will need to be a practicing Catholic and be a parishioner of your Church.

Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord

This weekend we celebrate a beautiful feast – the Ascension of the Lord. Jesus Christ, once crucified, has been raised from the dead and has ascended to the right hand of his Father. It happened **40 days** after his resurrection.

For forty days after his resurrection Jesus appeared many times to his disciples to assure them that he had risen indeed, and to prepare them for the task of carrying on the work which he began during his earthly ministry. Jesus went back to his Father in heaven, but he did not forget about his disciples and about us. **He is with us always**. He is present in the tabernacle, in the holy communion, which we can receive every day.

So that we will never be alone, Jesus has sent the Holy Spirit to us likewise he did to his disciples.

Jesus Christ, who went back to his Father after the resurrection, today and always, through The Holy Spirit, helps us to understand how to live the Gospel and spread the Good News over the world.

Dziś obchodzimy piękne święto - Wniebowstąpienie Pańskie. Jezus Chrystus, raz ukrzyżowany, zmartwychwstał i wstąpił po prawicy swego Ojca. **Stało się to 40 dni** po jego zmartwychwstaniu.

Jezus Chrystus, który powrócił do swojego Ojca po zmartwychwstaniu, dziś i zawsze, przez Ducha Świętego, pomaga nam zrozumieć, jak żyć Ewangelią i szerzyć Dobrą Nowinę na całym świecie.
