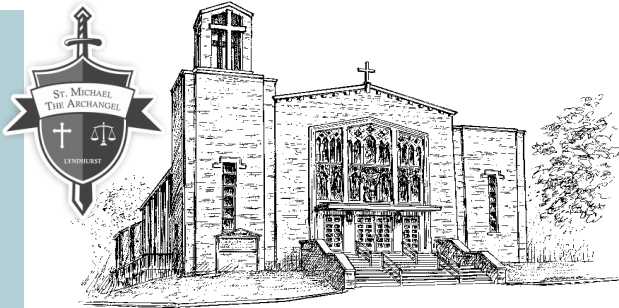

Updated Directives

Churches and parish facilities may return to 100 per cent capacity with no social distancing for both indoor and outdoor services and activities, as of June 4, 2021. Parishioners should be informed that if they are vaccinated, they are no longer required to wear a mask. It is not required for parishioners to show proof of vaccination. Anyone not fully vaccinated should wear a mask. Any vaccinated person preferring to wear a mask should feel free to do so.

The Communion Rite

The Sign of Peace should be offered but continue to be made without physical contact. Communicants will continue to receive Communion in the hand. If not fully vaccinated, they lower their masks to consume the host, then replace their masks. The chalice is still prohibited for the assembly.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today **The Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ** we examine how God continues to make himself present to his Church, how he sustains and nourishes us. God achieves all this through the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. Jesus' body and his blood are given for all of us. St. Paul said: **"He loved us and gave himself up for us."** Jesus loved us so much that he was willing to **be born** as we are born, **grow** as we grow, **die** as we will die. Jesus loves us so much, that is why, he left his risen Body with us **under the appearance of bread and wine. This is the Body and Blood** that we celebrate today. This is the sacrament of the Eucharist, in which we experience real presence and receive the real Jesus Christ in Communion. We meet Jesus in the Eucharist and walk with him throughout the day. In this way we receive spiritual and physical strength from God.

Drodzy Bracia i Siostry w Chrystusie,

Dzisiaj, w **Uroczystość Ciała i Krwi Chrystusa**, dostrzegamy, w jaki sposób Bóg nadal uobecnia się w swoim Kościele, jak nas wspiera i karmi. I w ten sposób otrzymujemy od Boga siłę duchową i fizyczną.
