

PREP REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR THE 2021 – 2022 YEAR

PREP will be offered in a **Hybrid** model for the 2021-22 year: one week in class with catechists & fellow classmates and one week at home, working with parents. This will be a pilot year to see how things go and if they go well, we will move forward the following year.

The **At Home Program** will only be available only to those who absolutely need it. In order to be accepted to this program each year, a parent must meet with the DRE and the request needs to be approved by the pastor. If accepted, a plan of action will be worked out and must be adhered to in order to receive credit for the year.

The **Partial At Home Program** will again be available for those families who need stretches of time working at home (seasonal sports, illness, family issues, etc.) Parents still must meet with the DRE to work out a plan, which must be adhered to in order to receive credit for time missed and for the year.

PREP Class Days will remain the same: Sunday Morning, 8:55 to 10:15 am, in time to make the 10:30 am Mass or you can choose Tuesday Evening, 5:00 to 6:30 pm

PREP Calendars will be posted to the soon-to-be new parish website, as well as be sent electronically. Hard copies will be available at the parent start-up meetings.

PREP Tuition will remain the same this year: \$100 Registration Fee per family, and \$30 book/supply fee per student. We ask that all fees be paid by August 15. If other arrangements need to be made, please contact Mrs. Romano directly.

Along with this information you will find a **PREP Registration Form**. Only families who are registering children for the first time need to fill out page 2 and to provide a copy of their baptism certificate. A completed **Consent Form A**, which will be available on the parish website, is also required for *each* student.

Please subscribe to the Parish **Flock Notes** by August 1. Go to www.margaretofscotland.flocknote.com Subscribe as an overall parishioner, as well as for your child's PREP day **ONLY**. I will subscribe families to the sacrament formation groups as they register. If you are already a member of a parish organization, you can subscribe to that group, as well. If you're interested in joining a parish organization, you must contact the person who is listed for that organization in the parish bulletin or website before subscribing.

Sacrament Formation Registration will be sent to all current families with children who are eligible for these programs. If you aren't sure if your child should be in sacrament formation, please check with Mrs. Romano, not your child's catechist.
