

Cleaner

- Please arrive according to the shift you signed up for. All volunteer shifts are scheduled to start 30 minutes before Mass begins
- Go to the kitchen and get your cart & trash can
- Place cart and trash can to the right of the entrance doors to the Church
- If the church doors are closed, please prop them open using the stops on the doors
- Place the homemade & disposable masks on the table with the hand sanitizer (check the sanitizer level)
- Watch as people arrive and if someone uses the bathroom, be ready to go sanitize it when they exit (touch surfaces – door handles, toilet handle, paper towel handle etc.)
- Sanitizer should remain on the surface for at least 60 seconds before wiping it off
- Always wear your gloves when using the sanitizer!
- Keep an eye on where people are sitting and touching (backs of pews etc.)
- If there are extra cleaners and the ushers need help, please help them get parishioners seated
- If someone uses the restroom during Mass, one cleaner should go clean the touch surfaces after they exit
- Attend Mass!
- When Mass ends, get the cart and trash can and wheel them into the Church
- When the first section empties, start cleaning it
- Spray back of pew and kneeler – leave for 30 seconds, then wipe down
- You do not need to clean the kneelers in pews that are closed
- Clean any other places you saw someone touch
- Replace blue crosses as needed
- Check Hand Sanitizer levels
- Replace cart/trash can to kitchen (daily Mass) or to Narthex (if there' s a Sunday Mass directly following)
