(Please gather and remain in the church. The Blessing of the New Fire and Procession into the church with the Paschal Candle will be celebrated with the Elect and Candidates.)

Night Watch of the Resurrection / Liturgy of the Word / Sacraments of Initiation / Liturgy of the Eucharist.

(Overflow from the main Church will be seated in room 7/8)

**Easter Sunday** - April 4<sup>th</sup>

**8:30 am & 11:00 am**

*Both Masses are celebrated in the Main Church and shown on the large screens with full sound in rooms 7/8 (2<sup>nd</sup> floor ministry center); and, the Msgr. Rauscher Community Room. Communion will be brought to these locations. (Go to the location of your choice. When a location is full you will be directed to the other locations.)*
