- ✓ Testing fee: \$20.00. Payable at time of testing. Testing fee is non-refundable. Testing date & time will be set up ASAP.
- ✓ **Testing is not a guarantee of acceptance.**
- ✓ Parents and child may be interviewed by the Principal of Sacred Heart School.
- ✓ If a student is placed on a waiting list because of lack of space, he/she will be accepted before other students in his/her category.
