Explanation of Tuition and Fees

ENROLLMENT/RE-ENROLLMENT FEE:

This fee covers annual SMART enrollment fees as well as creates a budget for recurring academic expenses, office and classroom materials and standardized testing.

CATHOLIC FAMILY TUITION:

This rate applies to families who are actively involved in their parish and who agree to the tenets of the St. Martha School Covenant. In addition, all parents should plan to be active participants in our school community and share their time, talent and treasure, as they are able.

NON-CATHOLIC FAMILY/INTERNATION STUDENT RATES:

Fees for families who are not practicing Catholics in a local parish. This fee structure also applies to international students studying at St. Martha School. All parents must comply with the tenets of the St. Martha School Covenant should plan to be active participants in our school community, sharing their time, talent and treasure, as they are able.

TECHNOLOGY FEE:

In additional to our typical \$175 book and supply fee, the additional \$25 will help cover the cost of school computers/iPads, software, support and network infrastructure improvements.

ACTIVITY FEE:

This fee covers the cost of classroom field trips, assemblies and school wide programs and events.

BEFORE/AFTER CARE FEES:

If using before care, it is a daily drop-in rate per child. You will be billed at the beginning of each month for the previous month's use. After care also has a daily drop-in rate and will be billed in the same manner as before care. If daily care is needed, there is an option to pay a full year rate. The full year after-care rate can be combined with tuition and fees and can be added to your overall balance in SMART. Otherwise, it should be paid in full with all other fees owed by July 1, 2020.

OPTIONAL ORCHESTRA FEE:

This fee is for students who choose to participate in our school day strings classes. This fee is paid in full to the school office at the beginning of the school year. If you are using SMART to pay your tuition, the orchestra fee cannot be added to your balance and must be paid separately as those fees go directly to our strings teacher.

SMART TUITION AND FINANCIAL AID

- Enrollment with SMART Tuition will allow you to choose a payment plan to pay off school tuition and fees. There are options for monthly, quarterly and bi-annual payments. If you would prefer not to use SMART, you must pay your tuition in full to the school office with cash or check by July 1, 2020.
- Families needing financial aid will need to complete an application through FACTS at https://factsmgt.com/parents/#financial-aid. There is a \$30 fee to apply and you will need to submit tax documentation along with your application. Once your application has been processed and reviewed, you will make an appointment to meet with our financial team to discuss the terms of your tuition.
