Budget Overview

- Updated Budget

Joy gave an update on the current budget. Expenses from last month were a shelf for the kindergarten class that was approved at the last meeting. The expenses for field day are now better estimated and are reflected in the updated budget.

- Remaining Funds

At this time there is \$11,999 in remaining funds. At the meeting parents were asked about ideas for the remaining funds. Some parents have suggested using additional funds for more basketball hoops. Mr. Bourque did agree that additional basketball hoops could be installed. This would cost ~\$3200 for two new hoops (purchase and installation and possibility of new basketballs). Mr. Bourque will need to clear this with Father Mike.
