- **Welcome and Opening Prayer**
  - Opening prayer said by Lindsay
  
- **Event Recap**
  - Trunk or Treat
    - Thank you Kelly Tinkham and Shannyn Mason for chairing this event. It was held on 10/31/21 due to the rain. Shannyn provided an update. We had a great turnout. Lots of trunks, kids and donations. The pumpkin and costume contest were well received. The White family was thanked for the DJ and the music.
  
- **Budget Overview**
  - Joy reviewed the current budget
    - At this time the revenue is ~\$46,000 . This is from the carry over last year, the used uniform sale and net proceeds from Boosterthon. After expenses are paid including additional expense estimates through the end of the year the remaining funds will be ~\$30,000. These funds are currently labeled under new initiatives but can be changed as needed.
  
- **Upcoming Events**
  - Catholic Schools Week
    - SPA is in charge of the pancake breakfast. We discussed going back to the way it used to be held with volunteers cooking the meal vs. purchasing the meals to go. The logistics may need to be adjusted to spread out a bit more but at this time we do plan on having our more traditional meal either in the Rose Garden or the Parish Center.
  
    - Entertainment for Catholic Schools Weeks is also a SPA sponsored event. Many different entertainers have been used. If anyone has any great ideas please share them with SPA.

- Holiday Event/Giving Day.
  - Community outreach was discussed in more depth with regards to a Giving Day. Mr. Bourque reported the teachers were in favor of this. Some classes do something on their own. Mr. Bourque to reach out to each grade to follow up with what they may have planned. He will share the feedback with SPA and we will try to come up with a plan for a SMCS Giving Day. The parish also has a giving tree (online) that SPA could potentially assist with. In the past crafts/cards have been made as donations to the local community.
  
- **Boosterthon Update**
  - Financials/Net Surplus
    - A net profit of \$37,364.41 (\$5600 more than last year)
  
  - Overall Feedback
    - The kids had a great time despite the change to an indoor run. Everyone loved the boosterthon t-shirts and they will now be allowed as part of spirit wear. We did talk about incentives and making them more consistent within grade bands and SPA offered some additional assistance with incentives going forward. Students did earn a pie and ice cream day to be celebrated on Pi day.
  
  - Planning for Next Year
    - Currently planned for October 2022 but the date has not yet been confirmed.
