Budget Overview

- Updated Budget

Joy gave an update on the current budget. At this time there is ~ 11,000 in remaining funds. Changes from last review included the funds raised from the uniform sale. Funds have now been spent on the basketball hoops (hoops+installation), the dunk tank for field day and the year books for the 8th grade class. There was some discussion about the remaining funds. We will be able to carry the money over to next year and earmark some for bigger longer term projects such as the outdoor classroom.

- Summer New Parent Meeting/Parent Liaisons

Mr. Bourque reports he has recruited some families to serve as parent liaisons for incoming new families.
