This Sunday afternoon is the Confirmation retreat; so the Confirmation class will not have morning class. Please pray for our Confirmation students:

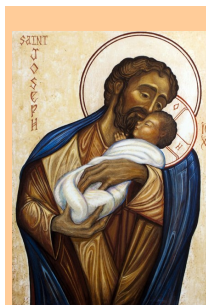

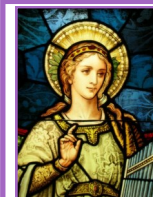
