This fall we are starting a second adult handbell choir open to high school students, college students, and adults. Both daytime and evening rehearsals are now available. The Saint Bede Youth Choir is composed of three smaller choirs that include youth in grades 1 through 12. Rehearsals are Tuesdays 5:00-6:15 pm. The combined Youth Choir sings and plays handbells every other Sunday at the 11 am Mass. Based on the Royal School of Church Music model of music education, the Youth Choir sings choral music, plays handbells and choir chimes, and receives Catholic liturgical formation. We are aware of issues with our 18-year-old sound system and are in the process of finalizing the proposal for a complete speaker replacement. With parts of the system not working, the sound in section 1 (to the left of the main organ), and in sections 6 & 7- near the statue of Saint Joseph, will not be as clear as in other sections of the church. We apologize for this. Just a reminder that the nave is outfitted with a T-coil audio system for transmitting the sound into a T-coil-equipped hearing aid. We also have FM earpiece receivers that you can borrow for Mass, just ask an usher. om your vocation to love and serve. Keep each other in prayer - especially those we serve at the House of Mercy.
