MESSAGE FROM MRS. SZUBA:

There is definitely a buzz in the air regarding schools. Are schools going to close or remain open, and who makes the decision? Here is what we know: the Archdiocese of Detroit has told us that the Wayne County Health Department does have the ability to close schools on a case by case basis. We are understanding that it will be based on positive cases in each individual school. The AOD is hopeful that we will remain open unless we have an outbreak within our school. An outbreak would mean that multiple cases were transmitted within the school.

Oakland County has currently recommended that all their schools close; this is a recommendation, not a mandate. If Wayne County would issue a recommendation, we would work with the AOD to make that decision.

We are remaining hopeful that we will be able to continue with face to face instruction for the foreseeable future. Let's all keep in mind that we need to be mindful of what we are doing in and outside of school so that we can all remain safe and healthy!

3. If results have not been met, email Chris DePerro at olvsac@olvnorthville.net

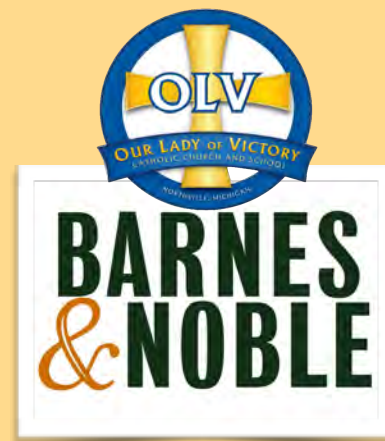
SAC will review your topic and offer a recommendation to the pastor and principal.
