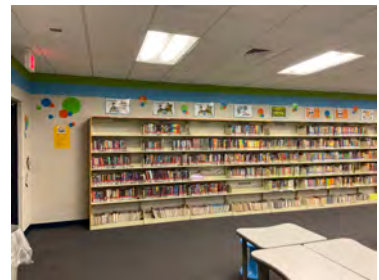
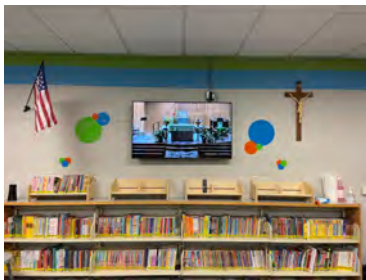

STUDENT ABSENCE REMINDERS

If your child is absent from school please follow these scenarios:

- 1. Absent due to illness other than COVID:** Contact the office. You may request absent work from the teacher; however, give the office/teacher a few hours to gather supplies.
- 2. Absent for personal reasons such as appointments or family getaways:** Absent work will not be guaranteed prior to the absence. The child will have the number of days they were absent to complete any missing work.
- 3. Absent as a sibling quarantine (per parent discretion):** You may choose to move the sibling of the quarantined child to the virtual classroom for the full quarantine period. Please notify Mrs. Kroll (bkroll@olvnorthville.net) and the classroom teacher(s) of this request.
- 4. Absent while awaiting COVID test results:** This would be considered a standard absence. You will not be moved to the virtual classroom.
- 5. Absent due to the mandatory class quarantine:** Your child's class will be moved to the virtual classroom for the quarantine period. The class will engage in the **Archdiocese of Detroit's Phase 3 Virtual Learning Plan** as long as the teacher is well enough to conduct instruction. If not, the class would engage in the school's current virtual learning plan.

THEROUX MEDIA CENTER NEWS

We are pleased to announce that the new Theroux Media Center was able to welcome back most of our students into the Library space this week! This year because of the current situation we have had to make some changes to book selection and checkout, with only a limited selection of books available each week. Books will be returned each week, but checkout will take place about every other week because books will need to be quarantined. We will continue to keep you informed as we "move through" this new procedure.

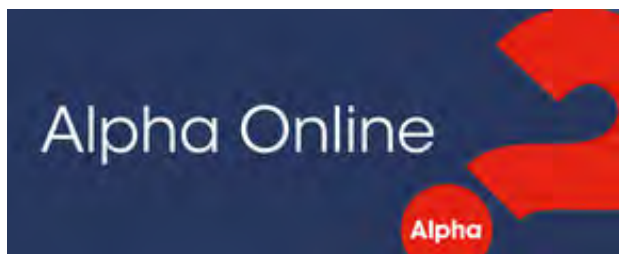
