

St. Anthony School Remote Learning Expectations

St. Anthony School is committed to its mission of providing all students an exceptional education in a supportive atmosphere. Amid the COVID-19 pandemic, this mission will include a remote learning experience for interested families. In order for this remote learning experience to be successful, the following guidelines must be followed.

Technology

- Families will need to provide their own adequate technology device(s) for the number of students participating in remote learning within the household. It is not recommended that a phone be counted as an adequate device.
- Families will need adequate internet connection in order to participate in remote learning. Families should verify internet capabilities and make any necessary upgrades prior to the start of remote learning. (i.e. SpeedTest)
- Students will utilize Google Classroom for all virtual learning.
- Access to a printer is recommended.

Daily Attendance

- Attendance will be taken for each day at 7:50am via a Google form. Students will be expected to reserve 7:50am -- 2:40pm for remote learning.
- Just as is the expectation for a regular school day, remote learning requires students to be participating in class activities. Students should not be working other jobs, shopping, working out in gyms, playing video games, sleeping, etc. during the school day. The school day is reserved for remote learning.
- Failure to check in for attendance is truancy unless a parent has contacted the teacher to report an absence that is considered an excused absence per the handbook.
- Failure to attend classes in their entirety without an excused absence will be considered truancy. Students with excessive absences may not be promoted to the next grade level.

Instruction

- Students will be presented with instructional materials related to lessons occurring within the classroom setting. The learning opportunities and

activities for students at home will not be identical to those occurring within the classroom.

- While grade level teachers will be providing materials and assigning grades for remote instruction, they will not be meeting with virtual learning students on a regular basis. Students will meet regularly with a certified SAS teacher assigned to remote learning.

Classroom Participation

- When scheduled by teachers, students are to attend all Google Meets or other “live” sessions, including times when teachers are giving timed assessments (quizzes, tests, etc.).
- When attending a Google Meet or other “live” session, students are expected to be on-camera (facing the camera) in an area conducive to study such as a table or desk. It is never permissible to attend a Google Meet or other “live” session while in bed, lying/lounging on a couch or chair, eating, etc. Students should treat it as regular class time.
- While on screen, students are to be appropriately dressed, wearing what is deemed appropriate for an out of uniform day in the handbook.

Assignments

- Assignments will be completed daily and submitted to the teacher before 8am the next morning unless otherwise noted. Students in 7th and 8th grades will lose 5 percentage points for each day an assignment is late up to 3 days at which time the student will be given a zero.
- Students will not be given significant extended time for late work except in rare and extenuating circumstances.
