Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper: This night has a special liturgical emphasis: the Institution of the Eucharist & the Institution of the Ministerial Priesthood. St. John's Gospel speaks to us about the commandment of love, which Jesus wants us to live by our actions. He showed His love by washing the Apostles' feet. We then remember that it was in this Last Supper that Our Lord gave the Church the gift of His Presence in the Eucharist. The procession with the Blessed Sacrament at the end of Mass is followed by a time of adoration & personal prayer in the chapel. Here we recall the Agony in the Garden, & the arrest & imprisonment of Jesus. The altar is stripped bare & crosses are removed. We are given the time to spend with Christ.

Celebration of the Lord's Passion: We gather in silence, without the traditional greeting because it is a continuation of liturgy begun on Holy Thursday. This is a somber & solemn time as we remember Jesus' death on the cross. A collection is taken up today to benefit the Christian community in the Holy Land. This money goes to maintain the holy sites & the small Christian community that exists there. This is a worldwide day of fasting & abstinence.

Easter Vigil: Our celebration begins after dark in order to let the light of Christ shine forth with splendor, & to show that this is the greatest night of the year, the Church's most solemn celebration. This is when we celebrate the triumph of Jesus Christ rising from the dead. This is a day of voluntary fast; we may wish to continue Friday's fast in memory of Jesus as his body lay in the tomb. Easter Sunday: We continue to celebrate the rising of Jesus, & our share in His life: *This is the day the Lord has made*, & we rejoice! After the homily, we all renew our baptismal promises, are sprinkled with Holy Water, & celebrate the Eucharist.

We hope everyone will make these days holy by their prayers, words, & deeds. Please participate, with your family, in the Holy Week liturgies—they will definitely enrich your life & your faith!

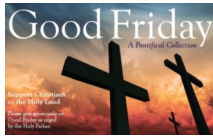
