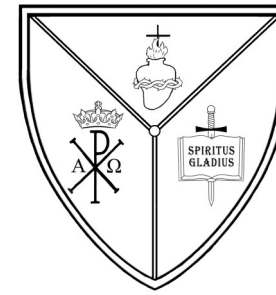

A couple of important announcements:

We are trying to put together a group of volunteers to help organize and serve funeral luncheons at the Athens parishes. This group would include men and women from the parishes who want to practice the corporal work of mercy to “bury the dead.” It may sound strange to say this, but a funeral luncheon, as a service to a grieving family, is a practical way to fulfill this corporal work. There are sign-up sheets at the doors of the churches, in the Holy Family Center, and in the Msgr. Kish Hall at St. Paul. We do not have many funerals in a year, so it would not require a big commitment.

Speaking of funerals, it would be nice if some adults would volunteer to be altar servers at funerals. Please contact Fr. Tom to volunteer, or sign up on at the bottom of the funeral luncheon sheet. Three to four servers for a funeral is ideal, but even one server at a funeral is helpful.

The pastoral council of Sacred Heart met last week and decided that over the next four months (from October to January) the Needy Fund collection on the first weekend of the month will be used for the Roof Replacement Fund. An estimate on the cost of the roof (which is currently out for bid) is \$112,000.00. In addition to the problems we have already had with the roof, shingles recently blew off the front of the roof (activity building side), so something must be done. We do have reserve funds and the DPSC rebate to help pay for this, but we will need ten to twelve thousand dollars more if the bids come back at the estimated amount.

On October 6 at 1:00 P.M., we will have the annual blessing of pets on the lawn at Christ the King.

On October 10 at the 10:00 A.M. Mass, Bishop Monforton will be here to celebrate a “White Mass” for healthcare workers and students preparing to enter the healthcare field.
