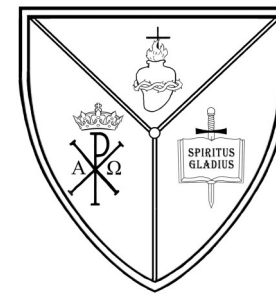

Claypool Electric is consulting with the company who manufactured the panels to see if we are able to repair the system, or if we have to replace it entirely. Obviously, the lights in church still work, but are controlled from a breaker switch in the basement rather than the church control panels.

A new dimmer switch has been ordered for the sanctuary lights at Christ the King and will be installed soon.

The basement hall lights at Sacred Heart have all been changed to energy efficient LED lights. Thanks to Danny and Roxie Marcinko and Myron Frankowiak for their work on this project.
