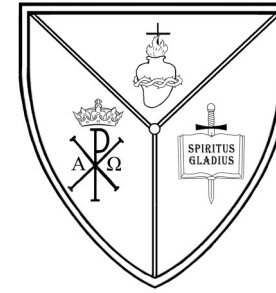

**HOLY CROSS DEBT REDUCTION NEWS-** At the end of February a payment of \$10,660 was made to the Diocese toward the reduction of debt for the parish, which dates as far back as August 2015. This payment represents roughly 27% of the amount owed to the Diocese for items such as unpaid monthly diocesan assessments and insurances. The amount owed is now down to \$28,641. The property insurance is paid in full and the property is fully covered through July of this year. This is great news for the parish!

As you consider your DSPC contribution this year, please keep in mind that any amount contributed over the goal is not assessed by the Diocese. If no other major expenses arise, part of the rebate could be applied toward the further reduction of the remaining \$28,641 debt.
