

ST. PAUL SCHOLARSHIP
2020-2021 Academic Year

Purpose:

To recognize the academic and community service achievements of St. Paul Catholic Church and Christ the King University Parish students graduating from high school and pursuing post secondary education.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduating high school senior with a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher
- Acceptance to a 2 or 4 year college or university, or 2 year technical, or performing arts school (e.g. music conservatory, graphic design)
- Family must be members of St. Paul Catholic Church or Christ the King University Parish

Amount: Up To \$1000

- The amount of each scholarship is determined by the number of candidates eligible to receive a scholarship, and will also focus on active involvement in church activities and Mass attendance. The total amount available is determined by the income available from the scholarship fund.
- Maximum scholarship amount is \$1,000.

Additional Information:

- Scholarship money will be sent to the approved applicant in July 2021. A copy of your Acceptance letter from a post graduate institution and your **final** High School transcript must be submitted to the Church Office prior to scholarship money being issued to an approved applicant.
- An Official Transcript from your high school must be included with the application. Applications will not be reviewed without this information.
- Include a letter of recommendation from one of the following individuals: one of your high school teachers; high school administrators (e.g. principal or guidance counselor); Community activity leader or director, or a member of your parish. Applications will not be reviewed without this information.
- This is a competitively awarded scholarship based on academics, church and community service, honors/awards, and activities.
- Scholarship must be used for the year it is awarded or it will be forfeited.

Request an application by mail, or in person, from the Athens Catholic Community Offices at 75 Stewart St., Athens, Ohio 45701. **Applications must be submitted, or post marked, no later than 12:00 p.m. on Friday, April 30, 2021; no applications will be accepted after that date.**
