

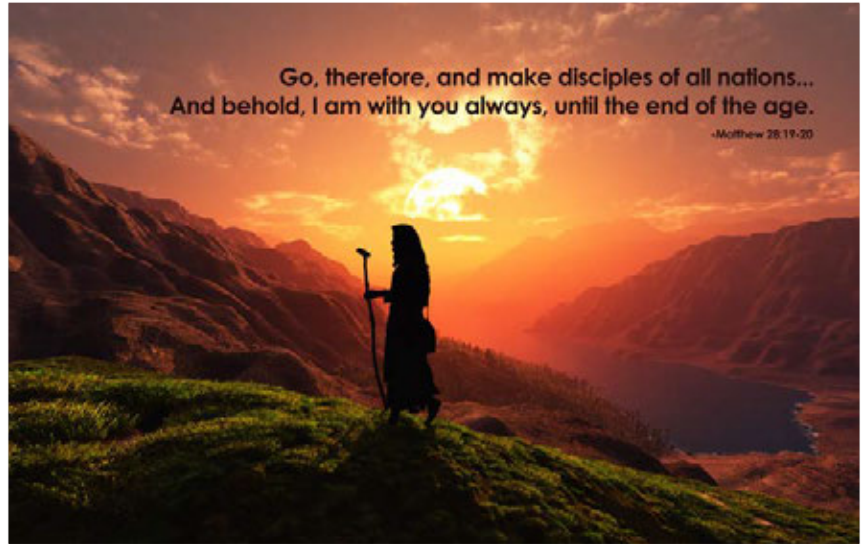
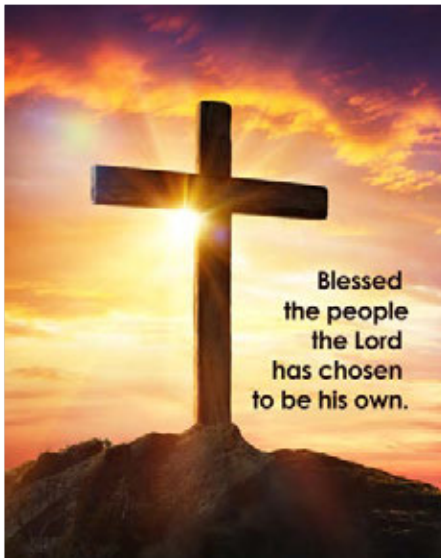

From the Pastor's Desk:

Dear Parishioners & Friends:

This weekend's Gospel comes from the final chapter in Matthew which describes what scholars call "The Great Commission," when Jesus gives the remaining 11 apostles their mission to go and make disciples of all nations by teaching and baptizing in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. It is a mighty farewell that contemplates past, present, and future in one brief statement. Jesus addresses the past when he notes that all authority in heaven and on earth has been given to him. Jesus addresses the present when he tells them what he wants them to do – he wants them to go now, to all nations (which was a bit of a surprise to his apostles and the people of his time). Jesus addresses the future when he speaks one of my favorite passages in the Bible, "And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age." He lets his disciples know that God's kingdom is coming one day, in all of its fullness and goodness and beauty, and that until then, he will be with them and with all of us. What a powerful and uplifting message for Jesus to leave them with.

My wish for us all is that we truly hear and accept the Great Commission and do our best to follow it in our lives. While not everyone can baptize, all of us can teach and evangelize starting now if we haven't begun already. We can infuse love into the everyday interactions and tasks of our daily
