

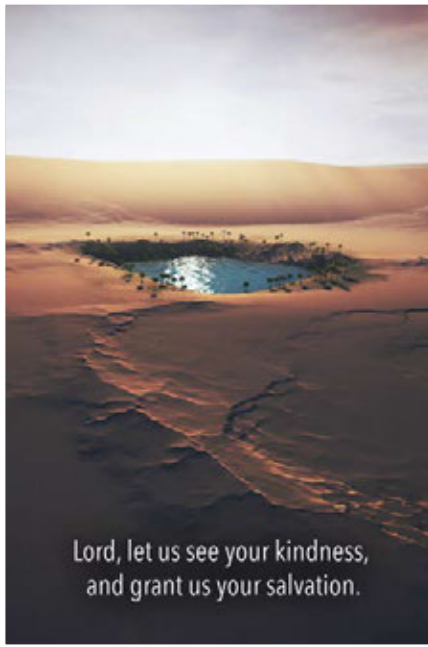

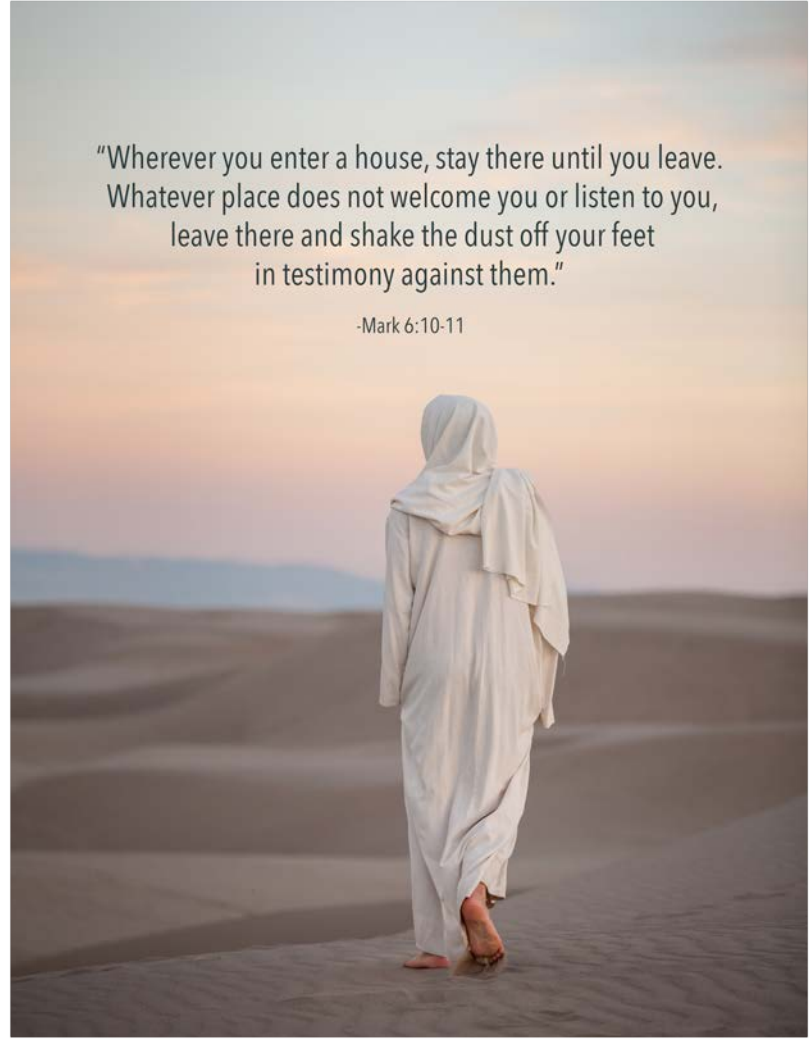
2021 Mass Book is Still Open:

that is often at odds with the image and impression of Jesus that is very prevalent today.

In today's common culture, Jesus is often portrayed as kind, approachable, almost meek. Religious goods stores sell any number of items with the initials "WWJD" (what would Jesus do?) and the common response is that Jesus would behave like a kind, calm, familiar, endlessly patient, forgiving, and accepting best friend who would never experience, let alone show, temper or walk away from anyone. While Jesus certainly is these things – in fact he is the very embodiment of love and forgiveness – he is also God, the Word incarnate, the physical embodiment of the force that brought us and all things into being. He was and continues to be many things – doing some things that are seemingly contrary. He would heal some and walk away from others. He was ultimately patient and kind, yet also he experienced righteous and right-ordered anger – as evidenced by his flipping over tables in the temple. He would feel great empathy for sheep without a shepherd, yet also tell his apostles, as he does in this week's Gospel, to respond to entire towns who did not welcome or listen to them by leaving and shaking the dust off their feet in testimony against them. When contemplating WWJD, all of this must be considered to ensure that we have a remote chance of reaching even a minimal understanding of him so that we may act and react accordingly.

My wish for you this week is to be filled with the Spirit as you hear this Gospel, so that you may reach a deeper understanding of the full nature of our Savior and his endless and boundless love for you – one that encompasses more of what he is than the simplified, one dimensional version so popular and prevalent today.
