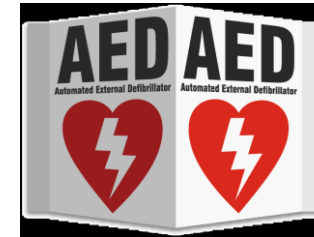




### Caragh Community Defibrillator
