Baptisms


Baptisms can be celebrated with a maximum of 6 people present. Contact the parish office on (045) 875602 for more information.

THE FEAST

As a further sign of His Forgiving Love, Jesus called for a Feast of Divine Mercy to be celebrated by the whole Church. He said to Saint Faustina: “I want this image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, that Sunday is to be The Feast of Mercy. On that day, the depths of my Mercy are open to all. Whoever will go to confession and Holy Communion on that day will receive complete forgiveness of sin and punishment. Mankind will not enjoy peace until it turns with confidence to My Mercy.”

THE NOVENA

Jesus also asked that this Feast of Divine Mercy be preceded by a Novena to The Divine Mercy which would begin on Good Friday. He gave Her an intention to pray for on each day of the Novena, saving for the last day the most difficult intention of all the lukewarmness of souls and indifference of which he said: “These souls cause me more suffering than any others, it was from such souls that I felt most revulsion in The Garden of Olives. It was on their account that I said, ‘My Father if it is possible let this chalice pass Me by.’ The last hope for them is to flee to My Mercy.”
