- For people who visit to tend to family graves: **A compost heap is provided for the disposal of grass and plants only.** Old flower pots and soil should not be disposed of in the compost heap. Please bring them home for disposal.
- The litter bins are not to be used for the disposal of household rubbish, - they are for litter only. (No rocks, stones etc.)
- People are requested not to use the graveyard to walk and let dogs roam free, because it is a sacred space.
- New signage is being provided, which we ask people to observe.
