The Lough Derg Pilgrim Path

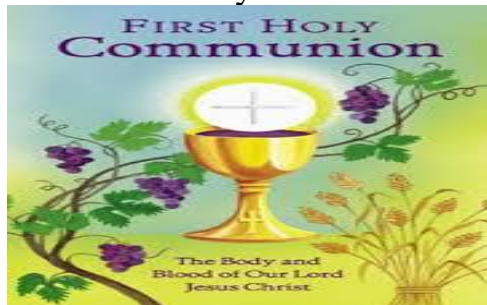
