NEW ICONS

We have been blessed with the gift of two beautiful Icons, presented to Caragh Church by Steve Higgins and his wife Mary (née Dunne, who is a native of Caragh.) They are delighted to give this wonderful gift to our Church.

The word 'Icon' in the New Testament means image or likeness. An icon is a work of art, but also a sacred window into the unseen world. Icons are said to be written, rather than painted, because one reads the rich message they contain. They help us to glorify God and make him present to us, as we are invited to pray and listen.

The Icon of St. Patrick is placed on the rural coastline of Galway Bay, with the Aran Islands, the Galway hooker (boat) and traditional stone wall as background. The colour blue (rather than traditional green) represents transcendence, mystery and the Divine.

The Icon of the Transfiguration recalls the event where Jesus took Peter, James and John up the mountain. "There he was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as light. Peter said "Lord it is good for us to be here."

In this icon notice how Christ is looking straight at us and is listening to our prayers.

St. Pope John Paul II said "The renewal of religious visual imagery is vital for our Times.
