



Covid-19 Information Packet 2021

Our health and safety protocols create a welcoming environment for our guests. Please note that the information provided in this packet is subject to change based on Texas State Licensing.

Pre-Screening

- We require all guests, campers, and leaders to monitor their temperature prior to arrival at Ceta Canyon.
- Each individual will be required to fill out the attached health screening form and waiver of liability.
- Both forms must be filled out and brought to camp. Ceta Canyon staff will collect these forms during check-in.

Sanitizing

- Ceta Canyon uses an upgraded sanitizer in our facilities.
- Common areas will be sanitized throughout the day in addition to the regular cleanings. Cabins will be sanitized at least once a day.
- Several hand-sanitation stations have been set around camp, and hand-washing instructions are posted in every bathroom.
- Staff have been trained to recognize symptoms of COVID-19.

Check-In/Check-Out

- A drive-thru style check-in will take place, and parents are encouraged to limit the amount of family members in attendance during check-in/check-out to minimize exposure.
- Ceta Canyon staff will take temperatures of all campers and guests upon arrival in addition to checking for presence of on-site Covid-19 symptoms (*listed at end of packet*)
- Ceta Canyon staff will also determine if the individual has traveled internationally within the last 7 days, or if the individual has been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for, been exposed to, or quarantined for Covid-19.

Masks

- Many people are following CDC recommendations and wearing cloth masks over the nose and mouth. Campers, guests, and leaders at Ceta Canyon are encouraged to make the choice that is best for them.

Social Distancing

- Occupancy levels in Ceta Canyon lodges have been decreased to provide more space for social distancing.
- Campers, guests, and leaders are encouraged to maintain 6ft of social distance whenever possible.
- Special arrangements have been created to allow groups to gather in a cohort, while providing distance from other groups.

Dining Hall

- The Dining Hall has been reconfigured to encourage social distancing. Groups will have assigned

dining areas.

- Food will be plated by Ceta Canyon staff and given to campers through a serving line. New plates will be provided for any refill requests.
- Ceta Canyon staff will prepare the tables for dining as well as clean up the tables after each meal.

We will continue to pray for our upcoming camp sessions and campers. Our prayer is that they experience an unforgettable summer of friendships, fun, and growth in a healthy and safe environment.

In an effort to minimize illness at camp, we request that you check on the health of your camper daily beginning **7 days prior to camp**. We want everyone's experience to be a healthy one and this begins at home. Please bring this completed form to camp on the day of arrival and submit at check in. **Please note dining is limited to 4 campers/guests per table.**

Please indicate if your camper has had any of the following symptoms prior to camp. If any temperature or symptoms are present, have your camper evaluated by a licensed health provider and contact your church or group leader for further guidance.

- Chills
- Repeated shaking with chills

Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/Covid-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID 19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to be spread by person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state and local governments and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have, in many locations, prohibited the congregation of large groups of people.

Ceta Canyon Camp and Retreat Center (“the Camp”) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19; however, the Camp cannot guarantee that you or your child(ren) will not become infected with COVID-19. Further, attending the Camp could increase your risk and your child(ren)’s risk of contracting COVID-19

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Camp and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Camp may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Camp employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risk and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my child(ren)’s attendance at the Camp or participation in Camp programming. On my behalf, and on behalf of my child(ren), I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Camp, its employees, Trustees, and the Northwest Texas Conference of the United Methodist Church, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, cost or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Camp, its employees, and the NWTX conference of the UMC, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation in any Camp program.
