

## The Ascension of the Lord

Lectionary: 58

Reading 1ACTS 1:1-11

In the first book, Theophilus,  
I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught  
until the day he was taken up,  
after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit  
to the apostles whom he had chosen.  
He presented himself alive to them  
by many proofs after he had suffered,  
appearing to them during forty days  
and speaking about the kingdom of God.  
While meeting with them,  
he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem,  
but to wait for “the promise of the Father  
about which you have heard me speak;  
for John baptized with water,  
but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.”

When they had gathered together they asked him,  
“Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?”  
He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons  
that the Father has established by his own authority.  
But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you,  
and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem,  
throughout Judea and Samaria,  
and to the ends of the earth.”  
When he had said this, as they were looking on,  
he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight.  
While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going,  
suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them.  
They said, “Men of Galilee,  
why are you standing there looking at the sky?  
This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven  
will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”

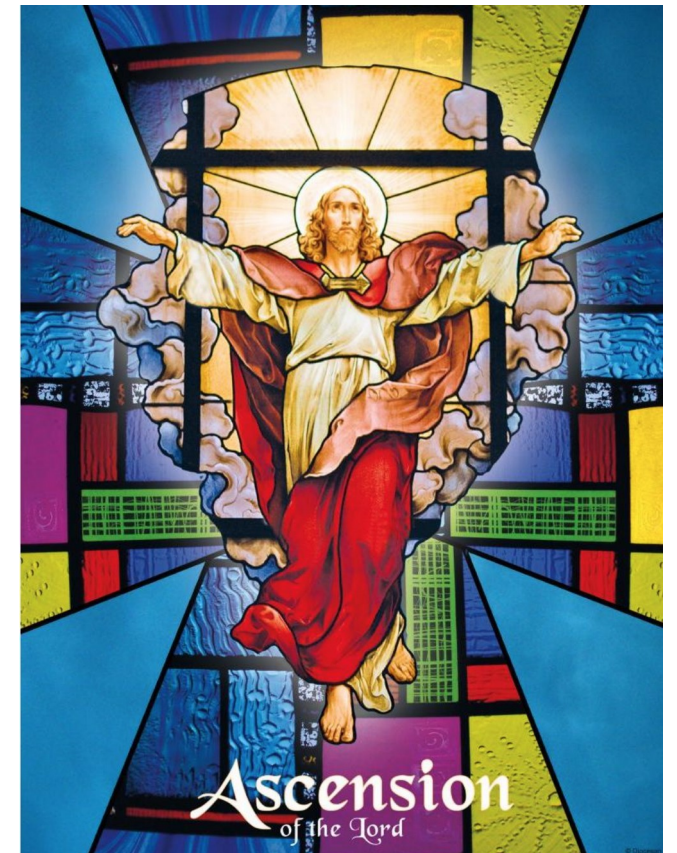

## GO AND MAKE DISCIPLES

In 1991, guerrillas in the village of Huasahuasi, Peru, executed Sister Irene McCormack, an Australian Josephite missionary. Her "crime" was feeding the poor. Despite warnings, Irene had chosen to stay teaching children in the impoverished village. One evening guerillas arrested her and took her to the village plaza, where her captors conducted a mock trial. Sister Irene was accused of being a "Yankee imperialist," pronounced guilty, and shot. The villagers remember Sister Irene and the five villagers who died with her in annual human rights events and community clean-ups. Sister Irene had explained to family and friends that the call to mission came to her through reflection and prayer at the age of forty. She described it as an irresistible inner voice. To be true to herself as a woman, a Christian, a Josephite, and a world citizen, she felt that she had to respond to the Spirit or risk spiritual death.

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## VAYAN Y HAGAN DISCÍPULOS

En 1991 las guerrillas del pueblo de Huasahuasi en Perú ejecutaron a la Hna. Irene McCormack, una misionera australiana de las Hermanas de san José del Sagrado Corazón. Su "crimen" fue dar de comer a los pobres. A pesar de las advertencias, Irene había decidido quedarse a enseñar a los niños de este pueblo pobre. Una tarde, las guerrillas vinieron por ella y se la llevaron a la plaza del pueblo, donde los que la apresaron condujeron un simulacro de juicio. La hermana Irene fue acusada de ser una "imperialista yanqui", la declararon culpable y la mataron. Los habitantes del pueblo recuerdan todos los años a la Hna. Irene y las otras cinco personas asesinadas con ella haciendo eventos de derechos humanos y limpieza de comunidades. La Hna. Irene le había explicado a sus familiares y amigos que ella había recibido el llamado a la misión a través de la reflexión y la oración a los cuarenta años de edad. Describió esa experiencia como una irresistible voz interior a la cual debía ser fiel como mujer cristiana, misionera y ciudadana del mundo, o arriesgarse a una muerte espiritual.
