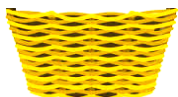

Make checks out to Roman Catholic Bishop of Stockton write *Spec. Collection for Haiti* on the memo line. All funds will be added to the Bishops' Emergency Disaster Fund for Haiti.

Parish Staff and Volunteers are working hard to keep the church clean and sanitized. The safety of all our parishioners is of the utmost importance to us.

For YOUR part we remind you that...
