Message from Father Steve,

The blinding blanket of white snow is now history—for now! The “polar vortex” has left a lasting impact on our society. It has helped us to realize our inadequacies while at the same time allowed the kindness of people to shine brightly. At St. Mary and St. Lawrence Parish, we continue our journey into Lent. The St. Mary PTO first Fish Fry was canceled because of the vortex, and some of our Ash Wednesday services were canceled. Let us pray and ask God to guide us through the trials this Lent.

This past week near Denver, Colorado, a spectacular event happened, and there were plenty of cell phones to capture the event. Only seven minutes after a Boeing 777 left the Denver Airport, the right engine exploded! Those with cell phones in hand recorded a loud boom and a massive flash of light! There was a brilliant transfiguration light in the sky. Today we hear in scripture about Jesus taking Peter, James, and John to a mountain top, where his clothes were transfigured. The three men were astonished at the majesty that is Jesus. Peter mainly couldn’t get over the visions he was seeing. If Peter would have had a cell phone, there is no doubt he would have pulled it out and captured the image.

We are all dazzled by incredible images; those who have traveled to a Disney theme park know how easily we can be fooled by “Disney Magic.” Make no mistake, what the disciples saw was nothing short of amazing. On the Transfiguration mountain, Peter and the disciples behold both the Jesus of the cross and the Jesus of the empty tomb. It is a vision that holds glorious promise — but a vision that will be realized only at a hefty price.

Accepting God’s blessing and joy is one thing, but when God asks us to “jump” — to give readily and humbly and sacrificially, to forgive without limit or condition — then we retreat to the “safe place.” The weeks ahead call us to descend the mountain with the “transfigured” Jesus and to take up our crosses, be they physical, emotional, economic, or intellectual,



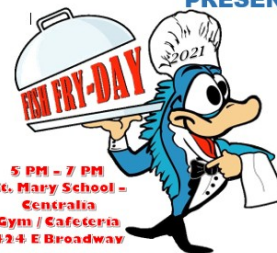

- Since we are sisters and brothers in the Lord Jesus Christ, to whom do I listen? What am I told?
- Since I am also “beloved”, what will I do?

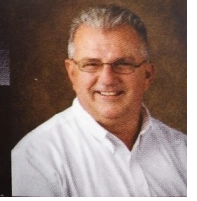

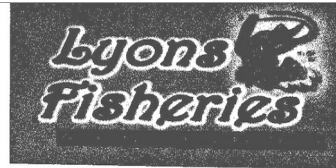
