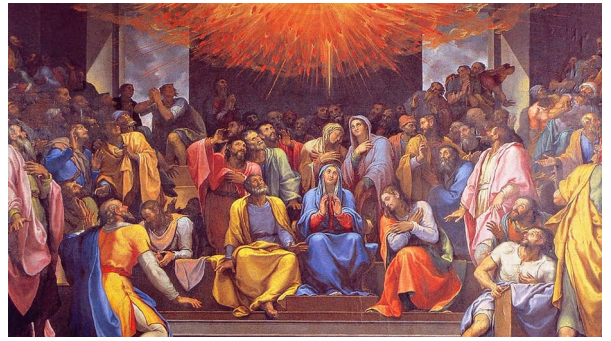

**“Now the works of the flesh are obvious: immorality, impurity, lust, idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, rivalry, jealousy, outbursts of fury, acts of selfishness, dissensions, factions, envy, drinking and orgies.”** In the Second Reading from a Letter of Saint Paul to the Galatians, Galatians 5:16-25, these vices all describe behaviors that work against the dignity of the human person, the human spirit. Today, we would add pornography, sexting, sex trafficking to the list. St. Augustine writes about living in the City of Man by loving yourself first versus the opposite, living for God and others, in the City of God. **Learn, Act, Connect and Pray**-Take time today after Mass to review your week. Are you promoting love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control to those in your social circle of family and friends? If you are, those are the fruits of the Holy Spirit as we work to give ourselves to God completely. Nothing we do for the sake of love for the other is done in vain. Christ calls each one of us to reach out, like Veronica, to those who are ignored, who are forgotten and to show love. 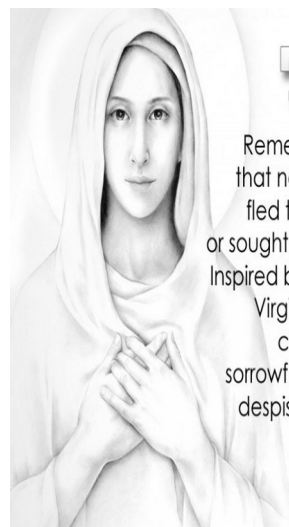
