“Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth.” In the Gospel of John Chapter 17, Jesus is in anticipation to be united with God, but urges God to take care of his followers. The Lord reminds us: Do not fear, I am with you. He speaks those words as someone who has experienced immense suffering. Jesus promised this when He gave the disciples the same mission He gives us: Go. **Learn, Act, Connect and Pray**—**Go be my hands to a world living in fear. Go to your aging parent in failing health who worries he is a burden. Go to the student who is beaten at home and doesn’t know where to turn. Go to the man addicted to pornography, living a lie in his shame.** Walk with each other. Do not be afraid to embrace God’s gift of life. Whatever storms or trials we face, we are not alone. He is with us.” **Behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age.** us, “We are prophets of a future that is not our own.”

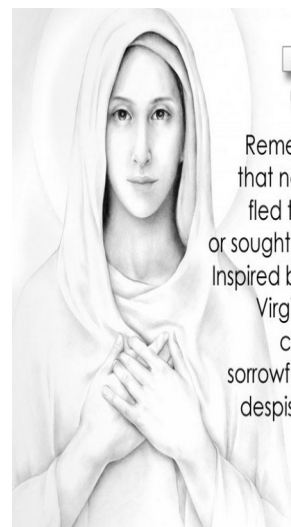
