

Cemetery Rules & Regulations

The following guidelines have been created in order to maintain the dignity of this final resting place. All maintenance within the cemetery grounds is reserved for authorized personnel only. The cemetery committee is authorized to enforce these rules and may remove any unsightly items or items deemed inappropriate. The cemetery committee accepts no responsibility to save or replace any such articles which have been removed or damaged. Maintenance crews are not responsible for any damage to decorations. The cemetery committee is not responsible for theft or damage to anything placed on the grave sites including urns and plaques integral to the tombstone. The committee shall not be held liable for any injury to persons or property which occurs on the cemetery grounds regardless of cause. Thank you for your cooperation.

Cemetery grounds are open for visitation from dawn until dusk. This cemetery is HOLY GROUND and should be treated as such. All work, such as opening graves (including opening for cremation urns), removing surplus ground, mowing, trimming, pruning of trees and bushes is to be done by authorized personnel only.

GRAVE DECORATIONS

Only one decoration per grave site is allowed and all decorations must be in good taste. Decorations are allowed from the week prior to Easter until November 15th, as well as for any religious or National Holiday. Non-religious items such as sports memorabilia, toys, figurines, personal items etc., may be used and should be removed within 14 days of placement. Any decorations should be placed on the monument or to the right or left end to facilitate mowing. **Any decorations remaining after November 15th will be disposed of by the cemetery committee.**

In order to maintain the beauty of our cemetery and allow for efficient maintenance, visitors must adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Fresh Cut Flowers**
Allowed at any time but must be removed within 7 to 10 days of placement.
- **Flowerbeds**
Not to exceed the width of the monument and extend no more than 12" into the gravesite and may be used for annual plants that get no more than 12" high. Potted plants may be placed in this area, or on the monument and should not be placed on the grass. This area must be developed and **maintained** by someone other than the cemetery committee.
- **Artificial Flowers**
Must be in good taste and of hardy construction to withstand the weather. Any items that become unsightly, weathered, deteriorated, or blown off the gravesite will be removed and disposed of by the cemetery committee.

- **Wreaths & Stands**
Permitted only from December 15 to January 15. If not removed by someone other than the cemetery committee by the designated date, will be placed behind the cemetery garage.
- **Flags**
Only National flags in appropriate holders are allowed.
- **Funerals**
Funeral floral arrangements or personal items may be left on the grave for no longer than two weeks following burial.
- **Holiday Decorations**
All holiday decorations, except Christmas wreaths, must be removed within 14 days of placement. Any decorations not removed within the allotted time will be removed and discarded by the cemetery committee.
- **Plant Urns**
Plant urns incorporated into the monument are encouraged and are to be emptied and turned down into the monument before November 15th.

The following items are not allowed:

- Bushes, trees, shrubs, or other perennial plantings
- Glass or tin containers, aluminum foil, or other unsightly materials to hold decorations
- Grave blankets
- Plastic border edging, bricks, bark, rocks, or other type mulches
- Balloons
- Solar lights of any kind
- Candles or other types of lights
- Shepard hooks or any other type of support for holding plants or decorations up off the ground
- Beverage containers, food items, or tobacco products
- Off-road motorized vehicles
- Pets - Service dogs are allowed and owners are responsible for immediate waste removal


GRAVE SITES AND MONUMENTS

Plots may be purchased from St. Olaf Parish only and may be sold back to St. Olaf Parish for the original purchase price. Purchase prices are subject to change. This is not a land purchase but an easement arrangement. Transfer is only allowed from a parent to a child with written consent granted from the remaining immediate family.

All monuments are to be a minimum of 4" thick and must be flush to the ground and placed on the western end (head) of the grave site in line with existing monuments. Please contact the Sexton to mark the placement of the monument.

Concrete borders are permitted, however, the cemetery committee does not recommend them as they are susceptible to damage during the winter months.

Full Size Grave = 40" wide x 10' long. One vault burial plus one cremation burial. In the event the casket burial is first, the cremation burial will be placed on top of the casket. In the event the cremation burial is first, it must be placed under the headstone.

Cremation Grave = 40" wide x 5' long. One or two urn cremation burial.
