  - 6.) Campus building Project for St. Joseph's will still be moving forward. Site plan has been completed.
  - 7.) Building and Grounds:
    - A.) Discussion was held on the garage removal project. No action at this time.
    - B.) We discussed feed back from the new sound system.
  - 8.) Family Breakfast: Previous Chairs and Co-Chairs are handing in the books for this Parish fund raiser, as they have done this for a long time. Thanks to them for time, talent and treasure these past years. We will discuss this at our next meeting.
