The mission of all liturgical leadership is to oversee the assigned areas, note areas in need of attention, bring new people into these ministries as much as possible. If you need help, please ask one of the ministers of hospitality or staff for ideas for new people to ask. We are getting new people back to the mass nearly weekly at all masses. Please be aware of the people you see every week, as well as the people who might be new.

MASS SET UP – PASTORAL STAFF/DEACONS – sets up in sacristy and sanctuary area

- Oversees Coordinators and Ushers
- Fields questions when Coordinators can not answer
- Opens church/locks church (Jim Reid opens on most Sun. mornings, also)
- Lights candles at the altar
- Lights paschal candle for baptisms, if needed
- Sets up vessels and books for priest:
 - Table at altar: chalice, paten with small presider host, purificator, bowl with water, white towel
 - Books and binders: Gospel Book placement/Gospel Book holder, Roman Missal/chapel ed. at chair Roman Missal/altar ed. on altar, Binder set up for priest, deacon and lector
 - Mass Intentions
 - Place copied sheets in binders and on altar
- Empowers others to assist, when needed
- Sets up binders for weekly masses
