### **GIFT BEARERS - Coordinator**

- Communicate with hospitality ministers, when necessary
- Facilitates the Gift Bearers
- Choose 2-3 people, using a variety of people each week, if possible
- Show the gift bearers the gift table right before mass
- The Gift Bearers will bring bread, wine, and low gluten small round pyx to minister at the foot of the altar
- Be at the gift table to assist the gift bearers. They are sent down the aisle as the deacon and/or priest move from the altar
