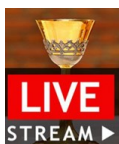

Fall Faith Formation

This fall we are offering in-person Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Confirmation Preparation for teens in grades 7-8 and a High School Scripture Study on Sunday mornings. First Communion and Confirmation 2022

- Confirmation will be celebrated on Sunday, February 27, 2022. Due to the early date, we have already begun preparation. All teens preparing for Confirmation (Catholic, public, and private schools) meet on Sunday mornings at 9:30.
- First Communion will be celebrated on Sunday, April 24, 2022. Children who are not in Catholic school are expected to attend in-person on Sunday mornings (or the Zoom option if appropriate for your family.) Children who are in Catholic school will join for mini-retreats later this year.

First Communion and Confirmation 2023

- The Diocese of Memphis requires 2 years of preparation for First Communion or Confirmation. The first year may be in the Catholic school / parish. 1st and 7th graders who attend public or private schools need to be attending our parish programs this year to celebrate First Communion or Confirmation in 2023.
- First graders may choose between in-person Catechesis of the Good Shepherd on Sunday mornings or Zoom I Am the Good Shepherd on Sunday evenings.
- Seventh graders need to attend in-person on Sunday mornings.
